### Vendor Rules & Regulations Agreement Form No Vendor Fee for 2025 Market Season

1. The Vendor agrees to all the following:

I have read and will observe the rules and regulations of the Chase City Farmers Market.

2. Market Schedule:

Held on Second Saturdays, May through September.

Spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

3. Items Allowed for Sale:

- Locally grown fresh fruits & vegetables
- Baked goods, fresh juices, pickled items
- Sorghum molasses, dried vegetables, and fruits
- Fresh eggs, honey, jams, jellies
- Potted plants, fresh cut flowers
- Crafts made by the seller

4. Additional Product Requirements:

Vendors selling dairy, meat, poultry, or perishables must comply with all regulations from the Virginia Department of Health and the Virginia Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services (VDACS).

All items must be grown, raised, or produced by the vendor.

Vendors must display a sign stating: "These \_\_\_\_\_ were produced by \_\_\_\_\_ in \_\_\_\_\_, Virginia (or North Carolina).

5. Labeling Requirements:

Vendors are responsible for proper labeling and inspection of all food items.

Labels must include:

- A list of allergens

- The following disclaimer: "NOT FOR RESALE – PROCESSED AND PREPARED WITHOUT STATE INSPECTION"

6. Items Prohibited from Sale:

- Flea market items or manufactured products
- Perishable foods not meeting safety standards
- Wild game, flavorings, or live animals

7. Vendor Responsibility:

Each vendor is individually responsible for the safety and purity of their products.

Vendors assume responsibility for any customer complaints or injuries related to their products.

8. Alcohol Vendors:

Bottled wine vendors must obtain a business license and a remote license from ABC authorities.

9. General Conduct:

All vendors are expected to cooperate with the event sponsor and staff.

### Waiver of Liability

I hereby relieve the Chase City Farmers Market, as well as the Town of Chase City, including their agents and employees, from any and all liability for damage, loss, injury, or costs associated with or arising from my participation at the market.

Furthermore, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Chase City, their agents, and employees from all claims, costs, and actions that may arise in connection with my presence and activities at the Chase City Farmers Market.
